Mounting Instructions

Open Trailers

- 1. Choose a mounting location on the rail of your trailer, that is directly over an upright support (See Figure 1).
- 2. Using the base plate of the rack as a template mark the location of the holes and drill with a 27/64" bit.
- 3. Bolt the rack in place.
- 4. Mount Blower Tube Support to back of rack (See Figure 2). Note: It can be mounted on either side of the rack, which side you use will be determined by your blower.


Enclosed Trailers

- 1. Choose a mounting location on the wall of your trailer, it should be directly over a rib support.
- 2. Install the top middle screw through the rack and into the steel rib support (See Figure 3)
- 3. Install the remaining screws.
- 4. Place the blower in the rack and determine the best location for the blower tube support.

Note: If additional clearance is needed off the wall mount a 2x4 cut 16" long vertically to the wall and then mount the rack to the 2x4.

Using the Rack

- 1. Place Blower into rack with the engine side facing outwards.
- 2. Slide the securing bar between the backpack and blower housing. Note: Some blowers will require a small modification (See Figure 4).
- 3. Use the supplied lock or pin clip to lock the securing bar in

Extensions

Extensions are used to stabilize trailers that have unstable rails, they also allow racks to be mounted to trailers with round rails. To determine what size you need measure from the floor of the trailer to the top of the rail.
